25. Public Comment

Nancy Fleming states that she has participated with OMDS for over 40 years. From a personal point of view, she states that it is imperative that the Board, the AG, the litigation staff and the attorneys involved work towards the highest standards as it relates to the foundation regarding her health, for setting the best possible medical care and setting the stage for health and the well-being of many.

Dr. Lisa Mathews states that she wants to submit an article from American Academy of Medical Acupuncture regarding dry needling. She states that the article supports that only licensed acupuncturists and MDs with 300+ hours should practice acupuncture. She states that this article states that dry needling is acupuncture and is not within the scope of physical therapy. She states that how the Board can afford an independent counsel when the AG has not been paid for a year. She states that the Board's funds are held in public trust and the AG is capable of representing the Board. Also, she states that the majority of OMDs do not agree with the regulation changes, capping online CEUs to 50%, the DAOM as an entry level accreditation or an oversight accreditation committee for the school. She states that the LCB has not approved the CEU changes and it is outside the scope of the Board's ability to restrict the online CEUs.

Dr. Daniel Davies states it was noted by Sunset Committee that the public comments are incomplete and he wants to see the comments in the minutes. He states that the Nevada Board has the authority to approve Wongu's program and review its curriculum but it does not have the authority to license or accredit Wongu. He states that Wongu has been applying for Title 4 funding with the Federal government which ruled that the Board is unqualified and without authority to supervise Title 4 funding. He states that Wongu went to the Commission for Post-Secondary Education for a license to operate in Nevada which it has received. He states that the Board does not have the expertise to accredit a college.

Dr. Sae Lee states the Board's major function is to set the highest standard. He states that there is some disagreement with the regulation and the Board should send the proposed regulation to the licensees to see whether they agree or disagree.

Dr. Michael Ferris asked when the AG opinion on dry needling is expected and the AG replied that it would be roughly 30-60 days.
