Dedicating over 50 years of her life to her work, Dr. Li-Chun Huang is recognized as the world's top expert in the field of Auricular Medicine. She has received the Recognition of Mastery and Lifetime Achievement Award at the World International Symposium on Auricular Therapy and Auricular Medicine. She has received a metal plaque award from the President of Italy, in recognition of the series of the treatments given to him during his visit to China. She led the delegation of the Chinese Acupuncturists to teach these skills to doctors in Cuba, and received the Friendship and Struggle Award and Certificate from Cuba's President.

Dr. Huang worked in the "301" Military Hospital, the premier hospital in Beijing, for over 35 years before coming to the United States. She was Chief Director of the Acupuncture Department of the "301" Military Hospital for more than 10 years.

1. Significances of Auricular Points

- e A micro-system of traditional acupuncture which reflects the conditions of the human body
 - internal organs, meridians, collaterals
 - nervous system, digestive system etc.
- e Like a computer window, it records all major medical information and data of the past, the present, and even the future
- e Used to diagnose and treat human diseases.
 - Points under normal conditions
 - However, during a pathological change the corresponding point will adjust according to the pathology and change shape
 - n points, areas, grooves, triangles, axis etc.

1. Significances of Auricular Points (cont.)

- e Each Point corresponds to specific area(s) and/or functions of the human body
 - Internal organs, collaterals, tissues, limbs, bones and channels.
 - Nervous system
- e The points and their counterparts are related through the “*Qi*” and “*Blood*” of Zang-Fu and Channels
 - The auricle is the place where “*Qi*” and “*Blood*” transpass
- e Physiological and Pathological disorders of the human body can be reflected on corresponding auricular points.
 - Diagnose diseases
 - Treat diseases

2. Nomination of the Auricular Points

- Based on their anatomical views of the human body
 - most auricular points belong to this category
 - Nervous system, Endocrine glands etc.
- Based on the theories of TCM, Zang-Fu, and Channels & Collaterals
 - Five Zang: heart, liver, spleen, lung, kidney
 - Six Fu: large & small intestine, stomach, gallbladder, bladder, san jiao
- Based on specific functions in auricular diagnosis and treatment
 - Allergy Pt., Anxious Pt. etc.
- Based on auricular locations
 - Ear Apex, Helix 1-6 etc.

3. Classifications of Auricular Points

- There are several methods in classifying or categorizing the Auricular Points
 - Positions
 - Functions
 - Relationships with the human body
- In this seminar, we classify them mainly based on their relationships with the human body
 - Specific Points
 - Points of Nervous System
 - Points of Endocrine System
 - Corresponding Points
 - Points of Five-Zang and Six Fu
 - Points of Posterior Auricle
 - Other points
