

Board Members

The protection of the public health and welfare is the primary responsibility of a Board of Oriental Medicine. Its authority is based upon the statutes and regulations and the Board members carrying out their duties and responsibilities.

President:

1. Determines Agenda with ED;
2. Answers questions from ED;
3. Conducts Board meetings.

Vice President:

1. Assists President;
2. Carries out the duties of the President in the event that the President is unable to fulfill them.

Treasurer/Secretary:

1. Reviews financial accounts;
2. Reviews expenses;
3. Signs checks;
4. Reviews minutes;
5. Oversees archiving.

Board Members in general:

1. Strong familiarity with applicable statutes and regulations;
2. Suggests topics for the Agenda;
3. Reviews materials for Board meetings;
4. Attends and votes in Board meetings;
5. Voice any possible conflicts and abstain from voting if applicable;
6. May make suggestions on items to improve the Board;
7. May sit on specific committees for special projects.
